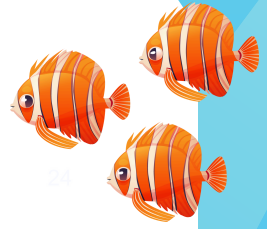


UNDER THE SEA

“Do you think we have a good chance of winning?” Nora asked.

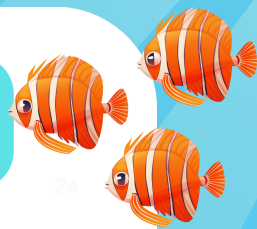
“Yes, I believe in all of you!” Mr. Perez exclaimed.
